North Bay Village is requesting \$575,000 to construct the Islandwalk-a 3,400 linear foot multi-use trail overlooking Biscayne Bay and parallel to the Kennedy Causeway (State Road 934/79th Street). The Islandwalk highlights the Village's unobstructed views of Biscayne Bay; creating a working waterfront. The public may use the Islandwalk to safely access restaurants, businesses, parks, housing condominiums, and Village Hall. The Islandwalk provides the only public access to navigable waterways.
