This project has been promoted throughout the Zephyrhills community, Pasco County Office of Tourism and the USTA. Representatives have presented locally the project to the Zephyrhills Rotary Club twice, to the Chamber of Commerce and it has been vetted by the Planning Commission and City Council. City Planner Todd Vande Berg presented the project to the Zephyrhills Economic Development Committee and at the City's First Annual Economic Summit, held in October 2017.
