Purchase of approximately 3,125 certified bear-resistant refuse containers that are distributed at a discounted rate to Seminole County residents that live within the County's UBMA.

17b. Describe the direct services to be provided to the citizens by the funding requested.

Utilization of bear-resistant refuse containers lead to a reduction of human-bear conflicts and serious injuries. As a result of the implementation of this program in Seminole County, reports related to bears-in-garbage have decreased by 58%, reports related to bear-animal encounters have decreased by 59% , and the total number of bear-related reports from within Seminole County's Urban Bear Management Area have reduced by 42%.
