16a. Please Describe:

During 2017 and 2018, the City of North Miami Beach hired design engineers Chen Moor and Associates to perform subsurface geotechnical explorations along the roadway and noted some areas where the roadway appeared to be sinking. The explorations concluded that large strata of organics were present beneath the roadway at depths from 4' to 10', providing unfeasible for removal. Alternate remedial solutions are currently proposed.

Roadway pavement sections (subgrade, limerock and asphalt) will be reconstructed and will include a geosynthetic base reinforcing material to slow the roadway settlement and distribute evenly. Minor storm water drainage system improvements will also be addressed as a result of the roadway reconstruction.

17b. Describe the direct services to be provided to the citizens by the funding requested.

Citizens will be able to take full advantage of a new, smooth roadway which will address slope corrections (a result of the pavement settlement), an improved storm water drainage system to minimize the intermittent flooding currently observed, ADA accessible ramps and sidewalks and new dedicated bicycle lanes.
