Dear Honorable Florida House Highway and Waterway Safety Subcommittee Chairman Steube, Vice Chair Raschein, Ranking Member Slosberg, Representative Ahern, Representative Avila, Representative Beshears, Representative Drake, Representative Kerner, Representative LaRosa, Representative Latvala, Representative Perry, Representative Rehwinkel Vasilinda, Representative Stark, Policy Chief Smith, Senior Administrative Assistant Manning, and Administrative Assistant Lawhon:

I supported Florida's "secondary offense" texting while driving law, until I was rear-ended, and my car totalled, by a distracted driver, three months ago (MBPD Case No. 2015-95439).

As a professional driver, I now feel panic every time I check my rear-view mirror, and see someone speeding while approaching me from behind.

I did some homework before writing you, including:

1. Speaking with public information officers at two local police agencies about this.
2. Speaking with the Florida Department of Transportation, Division of Highway Safety. And
3. Speaking with, and reading parts of the website of, the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration.

Are you aware that:

1. Of our 50 U.S. States, 42 make distracted driving (texting, etc.) a PRIMARY OFFENSE, i.e. ticketable without any other offense being committed.
2. Florida is one of only 4 States who make distracted driving a secondary offense (offending driver cannot be ticketed for texting, etc., while driving, unless the stop is made for a different offense).

and

3. The average time people -- like you and me -- take to 'sneak a look' (text, what-have-you) at their iPhones is 5 seconds. But
4. Only 2 seconds has been shown statistically to be safe.

I refer you to the following brief, poignant, discussions, which I found helpful, showing that failure to make distracted driving in Florida a primary offense will result in highway fatalities, and many, many, injuries:
