6 Section 5. Subsection (2) of section 180.02, Florida
7 Statutes, is amended to read:

8 Section 180.02 Powers of municipalities.-

9 (2) Any municipality may extend and execute all of its
10 corporate powers applicable for the accomplishment of the
11 purposes of this chapter outside of its corporate limits, as
12 hereinafter provided and as may be desirable or necessary for
13 the promotion of the public health, safety and welfare or for
14 the accomplishment of the purposes of this chapter; provided,
15 however, that said corporate powers shall not extend or apply
16 within the corporate limits of another municipality. Further, a

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17 municipality may not extend or execute its corporate powers for
18 the purpose of providing water service or sewage collection and
19 disposal service within the unincorporated area of a county that
20 has exercised its authority under s. 153.03 to provide the same
21 service or services within the county without the express
22 consent of a majority of the commissioners at a duly noticed
23 meeting of the board of county commissioners of that county. A
24 municipality, without such consent, may continue to provide
25 water service or sewage collection and disposal service within
26 an unincorporated area in which the municipality provided such
27 service or services prior to July 1, 2020.
