10 (3) Zero-tolerance policies must require students found to
11 have committed one of the following offenses to be expelled,
12 with or without continuing educational services, from the
13 student's regular school for a period of not less than 1 full
14 year, and to be referred to the criminal justice or juvenile
15 justice system.

17 790, to school, to any school function, or onto any school-
18 sponsored transportation or possessing a firearm at school.

19 (b) Making a threat or false report, as defined by ss.
20 790.162 and 790.163, respectively, involving school or school
21 personnel's property, school transportation, or a school-
22 sponsored activity.

24 District school boards may assign ~~the~~ a student ~~to~~ in a civil
25 citation or prearrest diversion program authorized by s. 985.12
26 to a disciplinary program for the purpose of continuing
27 educational services during the period of expulsion. District
28 school superintendents may consider the 1-year expulsion
29 requirement on a case-by-case basis and request the district
30 school board to modify the requirement by assigning ~~the~~ a
31 student ~~to~~ in a civil citation or prearrest diversion program
32 authorized by s. 985.12 to a disciplinary program or second
33 chance school if the request for modification is in writing and
34 it is determined to be in the best interest of the student and
35 the school system. If a student committing any of the offenses
36 in this subsection is a student who has a disability, the
37 district school board shall comply with applicable State Board
38 of Education rules.
