Statement from Majority Leader Ray Rodrigues on the Second Week of Session

Tallahassee, FL—Majority Leader Ray Rodrigues released the following statement.

“On the House floor, the Majority Caucus worked hard to pass noteworthy bills on the floor this week. This included revoking the use of red light cameras in our state, protecting property owners, and bringing funds to areas affected by the BP oil spill.

In committee, we furthered the discussion on how we can hold our government accountable, promote business, and close loopholes. A comprehensive bill was passed to deregulate certain professions to provide more job opportunities for Floridians while protecting their health and safety. The Ways and Means Committee passed a bill this week that will ensure integrity in the gaming industry, which will protect Florida’s national and international brand as a family friendly place to live, work, and visit.

Next week, our caucus looks forward to hearing bills on the House floor that address access to health care, transportation, and more. I proudly support our efforts thus far, and looking ahead, we will continue to fulfill the important work our constituents sent us here to do.”
